Each pair will be made up of one Event rider and one Show jumper, and each round will start with the showjumper jumping a set of show jumps, followed by the event rider negotiating a short course of cross country obstacles, finishing up back in the Arena over 3 or 4 show jumps. Pairs will be drawn at a briefing in the Owners & Riders Lounge adjacent to the VIP Hospitality at a briefing that all riders are expected to attend at 5pm.

Showjumping section: Fences will be a maximum of 1.30m, and 3 seconds will be added for fences knocked down.

Eventing section: Cross country obstacles will be built to a maximum of Intermediate height & difficulty. Show jumps will be a maximum of 1.25m with an optional joker at a maximum height of 135m (3 seconds will be added for fences knocked down).

22) MOTOR BIKES, SCOOTERS & BICYCLES Motorbikes & bicycles WILL NOT BE PERMITTED anywhere on the showground.

23) ESTATE.

Under no circumstances may any horse go on to any other areas of the estate, other than that area designated for the event. Any horse found outside of the designated area will be eliminated from the show.

24) TROPHIES.

Trophies are all perpetual & the winner is responsible for their safe return and insurance when in their possession. Trophies should be collected from the Show Office.

25) Electric Hook Up

A limited number of electric hook ups are available. The power source is via a generator. The event will endeavour to provide continuous supply but cannot guarantee this.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR ALL EXHIBITORS

- 1) Access to the showground on Tuesday 12th June 2018 will not be before 14:00. Competitors may not arrive between 2200 hrs and 0600 hrs without prior agreement with the show.
- 2) A 5mph speed limit will be strictly enforced within the showground.
- 3) Open fires will not be allowed under any circumstance. Purpose built Barbeques will be allowed under strict supervision.
- 4) Horses must not be left tethered or unattended whilst out of the stable or transporters under any circumstances.
- 5) Dogs off leads are strictly forbidden on the show ground.
- 6) The main fire point is located at the stable manager's office.
- 7) All horses must remain within the designated areas and walkways at all times. It is strictly forbidden to exercise or move horses in any areas other than those designated as walkways, warm up areas or stabling area.
- 8) The stabling area is designated as a no smoking area.

FIRE PROCEDURE

In the event of a fire:

- 1) Raise the alarm.
- 2) The Stable Manager will ensure that the Fire Brigade are notified.
- 3) Public address announcements will give clear evacuation announcements.
- 4) Stewards will assist the security and event managers in crowd control.
- 5) The show director will co-ordinate and evaluate the situation.
- 6) The show director will liaise with the Fire Brigade on their arrival.
- 7) Follow instructions from the Senior Fire Officer present.

Location and Getting to The Bolesworth International Bolesworth Castle, Tattenhall, Chester CH3 9HQ

Bolesworth Castle and the Estate are conveniently situated just 15 minutes south of Chester on the main A41.

The show will be clearly signposted from the A41.

From M53

Take the M53 South towards Chester. M53 becomes the A55. Leave the A55 at Junction 40 (previously Junction 37). At the roundabout, take the 3rd exit onto A51. At the traffic lights, turn right onto A41 signposted Whitchurch. Follow the A41 through Christleton, Waverton and Hatton Heath for approx 7.5 miles. Follow the signs for the appropriate entrance to the Bolesworth International.

From A55

From the North Wales direction, take the A55 towards Chester - branching left at Junction 37 onto the A55 signposted for Chester. Follow the A55 towards Chester and take Junction 39 (was Junction 36a) towards Whitchurch. Take the right hand lane at the traffic lights and turn right onto the A41 signposted Whitchurch. Follow the A41 through Christleton, Waverton and Hatton Heath for approx 7.5 miles. Follow the signs for the appropriate entrance to the Bolesworth International.

From M6

From the Birmingham direction, take the M6 North. Leave the M6 at Junction 16 signposted Crewe/Nantwich. At the roundabout take 1st exit onto A500 Nantwich. Follow the A500 to Nantwich. At Cheerbrook roundabout take the 3rd exit onto the A51 signposted for Chester. At the Burford Crossroads continue forward onto A534 Wrexham Road. At crossroads turn right onto A534. At T-junction turn right onto A49. Branch left onto A534 Wrexham Road. Follow signs for the appropriate entrance to the Bolesworth International (A534 - Wrexham Road / A41 Whitchurch Road)
